2024 SUBSCRIPTION RATES FOR JUNIORS

We have changed the way Juniors pay for membership, training and matches by moving from a 'pay as you go' system (pre-2021) to an online (Standing Order) system. The sum factored that some training sessions will be lost due to bad weather and assumes all players will play an average number of games:

Option 1 - 3 x Monthly payments of £35 due on the 1st of May, June and July, or
Option 2 – 1 x payment of £90 by 1st May

Payment for 2nd/3rd siblings (also applicable if you've already registered for ECB All Stars and Dynamos) will be discounted to £45 per child (one-off payment)

- Membership of the Club expires on 30 March 2025.
- The Club will communicate with its members using email (BCC). An active non-work email address must be provided. Coaches/Team Managers may opt to use other Apps for player availability and team selection (e.g. Whatsapp and Spond).
- Membership refunds will be considered by the Youth Committee upon request. Please remember that the Club is run voluntarily by members - prompt payment of subscriptions minimises our administrative costs.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS/SPECTATORS

1. Encourage your child to learn and play within the spirit of the laws of the game.
2. Help your child to recognize effort and good performance, not just results.
3. Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances of all.
4. Publicly accept the judgment of officials without argument or comment.
5. Discourage unfair play and disputes with officials/coaches.
6. Support your child's enjoyment of sport and help them to develop within it.
7. Use correct and proper language at all times.
8. Maintain responsibility for your child on visits to the Club at times other than to participate in any organised activity.
9. Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
10. Never force your child to take part in any sport.
11. Support your child by arranging transport for your child to and from the Club, ensuring they arrive at an agreed time and leave promptly after the activity.
12. Parents of U9s and below to attend practice and observe.
13. The misuse of IT sources and mobile phones is also prohibited and therefore could result in expulsion of the club.
14. Update Bradford on Avon CC of any changes to medical conditions and contact details.
15. We would prefer players & parents of players to refrain from smoking in the proximity of children whilst at Cricket

- Be a source of advice and information within the Club.
- Uphold confidentiality, as far as is practical, in all Club/Child Welfare matters.

BRADFORD ON AVON CC CHILD WELFARE POLICY

The Club is committed to creating and maintaining the safest possible environment for children to enjoy playing the sports and social activities offered by the Club.

We do this by:

Appointing a Club Welfare Officer responsible for child safety and as a first point of contact for parents, children and outside agencies. The Club Welfare Officer reports to the main Committee.

Recognising that all children and young people have the right to be safe, secure and free from threat whilst under our control.

Recognising that young people have the right to be treated with respect and their concerns listened to and acted upon.

Ensuring all our coaches, officials and volunteers are carefully selected and accept responsibility for the welfare of children in their care. Where necessary Criminal Record Bureau checks are undertaken.

Responding appropriately to suspicions or allegations by providing parents and children with the opportunity to voice concerns.

CODES OF CONDUCT

Bradford on Avon CC has adopted a code of conduct for members including children and parents. Bradford on Avon CC is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting its membership. The Club believes it is important that everyone associated with the Club should, at all times, show respect to others, be encouraged to be open, and share any concerns or complaints with the appropriate Club Welfare Officer.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR JUNIOR MEMBERS

1. Play within the laws and in the spirit of the game.
2. Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Respect teammates, opponents and officials. Do not make derogatory comments or gestures about teammates or opponents. Never try to intimidate the opposition by threats or excessive triumphalism.
3. Be polite to officials and respect their decisions. Do not show dissent or throw tantrums.
4. Keep to agreed timings for practice and matches or inform the team manager or lead coach a.s.a.p. if unable to play or are going to be late.
5. Players must wear appropriate protective equipment (e.g. approved helmet, box, pads and gloves) when batting or wicket keeping for all hardball cricket matches and net practices.
6. Wear the appropriate match kit (clean whites, club baseball cap and white cricket shoes or trainers) – properly and with pride!
7. The misuse of IT sources and mobile phones is also prohibited and therefore could result in expulsion of the club.
8. Do not use mobile phones/cameras in changing area environments.
9. Remember that all fees must be paid promptly.
10. Never smoke on the cricket ground or whilst representing the club.
11. Never consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on club premises or whilst representing the club.
